

Supervision Policy

Reviewed and updated on 01.09.2025

Introduction

The aim of this policy is to ensure that teachers and staff at L'école bilingue fully understand their role and responsibility in ensuring pupils safety whilst in the school's care.

Before school

Start of the day is as follow:

- **8h30:** early children / Welcome in playground / Parents leave their children at the gate.
- **8h45:** Elementary school only / Welcome in playground / Parents leave their children at the gate.
- **9 to 9:10 am:** Nursery school / Welcome in classroom → lessons start at 9:15 am
- **8:45 to 8:55 am:** CP & CE1 / Teachers call pupils in playground / Welcome in classroom → lessons start at 9 am.
- **8:30 to 8:40 am:** CE2, CM1&CM2/ Teachers call pupils in playground/Welcome in classroom → lessons start at 8:45 am
- **9:10 am:** Gates close

Pupils may arrive before 9am. Parents can drop their children from 8.30 when a member of staff is on duty in the school playground.

"Maternelle" children in the playground are taken in the main hall upstairs at 8.45.

Elementary children stay in playground when a member of staff is on duty in the school playground.

Break Periods

A rota for adult supervision of pupils is in place. A minimum of 2 adults per break are on duty when nursery children are out at play and 1 adult for elementary children.

In the event of inclement weather, nursery children will remain in the nursery hall upstairs. Elementary children will remain in their classroom where adult staff will ensure regular supervision throughout.

Lunchtimes

A rota for adult supervision of pupils is in place. Children are supervised by a minimum of 3 adults (2 teachers, 1 kitchen assistant in nursery and 2 kitchen assistant and 1 teacher in elementary).

After School

Nursery and Elementary children are taken to the main gate by their teacher and handed over to their parents or a designated adult. If it is the wish of their parents, and provided a request has been received in writing, Y6 children are allowed to make their own way home.

Leaving School

No child should leave the premises during the school day unless agreed with and picked up by the parents or other adults parents have officially authorized to pick them up.

After School Care or Clubs

After-school care or clubs are provided until 5.00/5:10 pm respectively. Children attending the After School Care are picked up by their parents or a designated adult.

Parents whose children attend School Club must follow the Parents Association (APEB) policy given to them at registration.

- **8h30-8h40** : Accueil des enfants du cycle 3 d'Elémentaire (CE2/CM1/CM2) – Aucun parent n'est autorisé dans la cour / *Welcome for children of CE2/CM1/CM2 in Élémentaire – No parents in the playground*
- **8h45-8h55** : Accueil des enfants du cycle 2 d'Elémentaire (CP/CE1) – Aucun parent n'est autorisé dans la cour / *Welcome for children of CP & CE1 classes in Élémentaire – No parents in the playground*
- **9h-9h10** : Accueil des enfants de Maternelle – Aucun parent n'est autorisé dans la cour / *Welcome for children of Maternelle – No parents in the playground*
- **9h10** : Fermeture du portail / *Gate closure*

APRES-MIDI / AFTERNOON

- **15h30 (Mer./Wed. 12h15)** : Fin de journée pour la Petite Section, la Moyenne Section et la Grande Section (Maternelle)- Les enseignants accompagnent leurs élèves au portail. / *End of day for Élémentaire - Teachers take their pupils to the gate.*
- **15h45 (Mer./Wed. 11h45)** : Fin de journée pour les classes de CE2, CM1 & CM2 (Elémentaire) - Les enseignants accompagnent leurs élèves au portail. / *End of day for CE2m CM1 & CM2 classes - Teachers take their pupils to the gate.*
- **16h (Mer./Wed. 12h)** : Fin de journée pour les classes de CP & CE1 (Elémentaire) - Les enseignants accompagnent leurs élèves au portail. / *End of day for CP & EC1 classes Élémentaire - Teachers take their pupils to the gate.*
- **16h-17h (Mer./Wed. 12h-13h)** : Garderie (£5)/ *After school care (£5)*
Parents of children in Maternelle who are staying after 15h30 (Mon., Tue., Thu. and Fri.) and after 12h15 will be charged.
Parents of children in CP & CE1 who are staying after 16h (Mon., Tue., Thu. and Fri.) and after 12h will be charged.
Parents of children in CE2, CM1 and CM2 who are staying after 15h45 (Mon., Tue., Thu. and Fri.) and after 11h45 will be charged.
